## Champagne & Sparkling Wine

<b>PROSECCO BRUT ROSE Borgo Coldelalto. Treviso, Italy</b>	NV	£39
A delicate pink sparkling wine made from the Prosecco grape. Fragrant with summer fruit aromas, fresh and lively on the palate, dry, crisp and easy to drink.		
<b>DÉLAMOTTE Brut</b>	NV	£45
This champagne has an enticingly fresh vibrancy, yet a perfectly balanced acidity. There is underlying richness too and a fine mineral character.		
<b>POL ROGER Brut Reserve "White Foil"</b>	NV	£65
Very soft, luscious mousse and an overall fruity impression, baked apples and fine apple acidity in the finish.		
<b>DÉLAMOTTE Rose Brut</b>	NV	£75
Delicate and fine with appealing wild strawberry fruit, Delamotte's subtle rose Champagne is as moreish as it is rare.		
<b>POL ROGER Vintage Brut</b>	2000	£90
Elegant and ripe with a delicious, underlying toastiness. Showing aromas of dried fruits, butter and nougat with a fleshy texture, which is balanced by its elegance and freshness. The impression is one of fine balance between power and finesse.		
<b>KRUG Grande Cuvée</b>	NV	£170
<i>"Krug is the champagne that God gives his angels when they have been especially good!" Paul Levy.</i>		
Beautiful pale golden colour with a very fine mousse. The nose shows elegance and finesse with toasty hazel nut aromas and touches of honey. Incredibly rich with a fantastically full fruit but is perfectly dry, mellow and complex.

### France

<b>PINOT GRIS TZIGANÉ Henri Fuchs</b>	2009 Alsace	£39
Big, opulent, luscious wine with spices, honey and a long dry finish that works with just about everything on the menu!		
<b>GEWURZTRAMINER Henri Fuchs</b>	2009 Alsace	£35
Full throttle, voluptuous wine from a small, highly regarded house. Spice, rose petal, wild honey and lychees with a hauntingly long finish.		
<b>MUSCADET "Catch of the Day"</b>	2010 Loire	£21
Fresh, dry and fruity made with passion & a light touch, which will brighten even an English Summers day! With white flowers, soft citrus fruits & a crisp finish this wine is great value for money!		
<b>SANCERRE Roland Tissier</b>	2010 Loire	£39
Big award winner from highly regarded winemaker. Absolutely classic style; Grass, herbs and blackcurrant twig with a steely backbone and long clean mineral finish.		
<b>POUILLY FUME Villas Paulus</b>	2009 Loire	£45
Bright gooseberry fruit with a rich & rounded palate. Bracing citrus fruit with underlying mineral notes & a long, elegant finish. Bronze Award winner at the Challenge International du Vin.		

<b>POUILLY FUISSE Moulin du Pont</b>	<b>2008/9 Burgundy</b>	<b>£38</b>
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This producer received 5 stars in Decanter in December and was Gold medal winner in their Pouilly Fuisse tasting! Brioche and lemon curd flavours with a long creamy finish and touch of vanilla oak.

<b>MONTAGNY BONNEVEAUX 1ER CRU Olivier Leflaive</b>	<b>2009 Burgundy</b>	<b>£43</b>
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Montagny is a great source of characterful wines that are well priced for the quality. Olivier Leflaive is a dynamic, boutique negotiant business making wines for immediate pleasure.

<b>CHABLIS 1ER CRU Les Lys Domaine Vincent Damp</b>	<b>2009/10 Burgundy</b>	<b>£54</b>
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This was Decanter Magazines 5 star gold medal winning wine in their last 1er Cru Chablis panel tasting. Citrus, Orchard Fruit & perfect balance of Seashell minerality & rich creaminess.

<b>MEURSAULT Henri Darnat</b>	<b>2008/9 Burgundy</b>	<b>£68</b>
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Henri Darnat is something of a cult figure in Meursault & we believe he makes some of the finest wine of the Appellation. Fragrant, honeyed, citrus fruit.

<b>PULIGNY MONTRACHET Olivier Leflaive</b>	<b>2007/9 Burgundy</b>	<b>£75</b>
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Organically produced Puligny Montrachet from the family's own vineyard. A perfect balance of minerality & opulent orchard fruit, gently perfumed with white flowers.

<b>CORTON-CHARLEMAGNE Grand Cru Bonneau du Martray</b>	<b>1994 Burgundy</b>	<b>£130</b>
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Wonderfully golden in colour. On the palate, the balance, roundness and power is overwhelming with notes of almonds and grilled fennel coming to the fore. The length and balance of this wine, reveals why this is a Grand Cru.

<b>SAINT JOSEPH Cave De Saint Desirat</b>	<b>2009 Rhone</b>	<b>£39</b>
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Ripe, rounded white orchard fruit complemented by peach & apricot notes with a well balanced, dry finish.

<b>CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE Domaines Brunier</b>	<b>2010 Rhone</b>	<b>£55</b>
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Honeysuckle and acacia on the nose with a concentrated palette of peaches and apricots with honeyed acidity and a touch of spice; this is a beautifully rich spicy winter white almost made for Christmas time!

<b>VERMENTINO 'ADVOCATE' Domaine ST Hilaire</b>	<b>2007/10 Languedoc</b>	<b>£24</b>
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The Vermentino is a little-known variety that produces a pale green, floral, soft and mouth-filling dry white. Deliciously crisp and with a clean refreshing fruitiness. This wine is from old vines so also has great character & surprising complexity.

### Austria & Italy

<b>GAVI DI GAVI Fratelli Levis</b>	<b>2009/10 Piedmont</b>	<b>£31</b>
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Ripe pear and white flowers dominate in this pretty & elegant Gavi di Gavi. This is a beautifully refreshing wine with pleasing weight and a delicate, mineral finish.

<b>PINOT GRIGIO St Micheal Eppan</b>	<b>2008/10 Tyrol</b>	<b>£38</b>
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Hand harvested grapes undergo fermentation in stainless steel tanks. Excellent acidity, balance & structure. Loaded with intense apple and pear fruit, and oodles of thirst quenching acidity. This is one of the best Pinot Grigios that you will find.

<b>GRUNER VELTLINER Loimer</b>	<b>2010 Kamptal</b>	<b>£42</b>
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Juicy apple, pear and citrus aromas with floral notes; typical peppery veltliner spice. A robust fruit core and firm mineral structure yield a balanced wine with good finesse.

**RIESLING Brundlmayer** 2002/6 Kamptal £50  
 Fabulously aromatic with acacia, peach, lime & fresh fruit; classically dry with amazing acidity to keep it raptier fresh.

### Spain & Portugal

**MONTE VELHO ALENTEJANO, Herdade do Esporao** 2010 Reguengos, Portugal £26  
 Lovely weight on the palate with soft round acidity, loads of citrus flavour & hint of spice. Full, flavoursome yet well balanced.

**RIOJA, Monopole Blanco CVNE** 2008 Rioja, Spain £35  
 Classic White Rioja, full bodied and dry, with a crisp fruitiness & a good dollop of creamy vanilla oak. Combines the classical use of American oak with the intense fruity flavours & refreshing acidity of the Viura and Malvasia varieties beautifully.

**VEIGADARES ALBARINO Adegas Galegas** 2008 Rías Baixas, Spain £40  
 About as good as Albarino gets & recently voted the top Albarino in the UK. Delicate peachy aromas & a full spiced pear, citrus & peach palate with a dry finish.

### The Americas

**CHARDONNAY Cutler Crest** 2010 California £16  
 Deep golden in colour with apple-pear nuances on the nose. Crisp in the mouth, this wine shows flavors of peaches & apricots on the palate with a hint of vanilla oak and acidity.

**SAUVIGNON BLANC Reserva, Vina Mar** 2010 Casablanca, Chile £25  
 Awarded a gold list place in the Sommelier Awards 2009. Clean and crisp with nettle and gooseberry with a lemony zip running alongside richer topicality. More New Zealand style than the Catamayor.

**SAUVIGNON BLANC Catamayor** 2010 San Jòse, Uruguay £25  
 Excellent concentration in flavour and aromas. Elegantly fresh & lively with a green gauge like fruit & perfect balancing acidity. More elegant & French in style than the Vina Mar Reserva.

### South Africa

**CHENIN BLANC Jordan Vineyards** 2009 Stellenboch £30  
 Layers of rich tropical fruit and creamy citrus flavours, interlaced with a spicy, white peppercorn complexity from barrel-fermentation create a well-balanced wine with a natural fruity acidity.

**CHARDONNAY Paul Cluver** 2009 Elgin £39  
 The flavours are complex and show a well-integrated combination of ripe fruit and nuances of oak. As you sip, the flavours are long and lingering. A truly beautiful Chardonnay!

### New Zealand & Australia

**UNOAKED CHARDONNAY The Lane** 2009 Adelaide Hills, Aus. £35  
 This is a perfect example of an unoaked Chardonnay; ripe with delicious tropical & stone fruits, there is an underlying acidity keeping the wine fresh & vibrant.

**PINOT GRIS Roaring Meg** 2009 Central Otago, NZ £36  
 This wine has aromatics reminiscent of a fruit cocktail full of white pear, passion fruit and melon. On the palate this is duplicated with lovely rich flavours, a textured mid palate and an off-dry finish.

**SAUVIGNON BLANC Eradus****2009 Marlborough, NZ £39**

The grapes are picked fully ripe which gives a more exotic, slightly richer palate than many of the regions wines. Passion fruit & Asparagus flavours with a long, delicate, nettley finish.

**SEMILLON Rockford Local Growers****2003 Barossa Valley, Aus. £42**

Rich & full bodied with a lovely, light golden colour & an inviting lemon & apricot nose with just a hint of butteriness. It is soft, rich & exciting on the palate with excellent acid structure. Nice balance, only 11.5% alcohol and you don't notice any of it.

**VIOGNIER The Lane****2007 Adelaide Hills, Aus. £49**

Plenty of rich, fleshy fruit with a great citric acidity to cut through on the mid palate. The finish shows subtle oaky spice. This wine was a placebo in a recent Condrieu tasting & it was placed first. It is absolutely delicious.

**Rose Wine****BEAJOUAIS ROSE Domaine de Grandmot, Blace,****2009 Beaujolais, France £26**

Pale pink, fresh, dry and fruit driven - Great food wine

**VILLA WOLF PINOT NOIR ROSE Wachenheim****2010 Rheinpfalz, Germany £29**

Rich, full flavoured & off dry with a creamy texture & a splash of strawberry essence running through.

**CLASSIC ROSE Massaya****2010 Bekaa Valley, Lebanon £35**

Deliciously perfumed with fresh strawberry aromas & a touch of spice. This is a light peachy coloured rosé, dry & fresh in style with creamy fruit on the palate. A very versatile rosé, brilliant with food.

**Red Wine****France****MARSANNAY Dupont-Tisserandot****2009 Burgundy £45**

Hand crafted, medium bodied wine of the highest quality. Rich ripe raspberry fruit, firm tannins & a solid earthy structure.

**BEAUNE Domaine Pascal Bouley****2005 Burgundy £52**

A wonderful expression of Beaune; full of ripe strawberry fruit with a classic hint of truffley game showing through.

**MONTHELIE Le Clos Gauthey 1er CRU****2007 Burgundy £63**

Very sexy nose. Barnyard, silage... all of the classic and often elusive aromas that define top class aged burgundy. Following through on the palate with well-integrated fruit and oak.

**CLOS VOUGEOT Grand Cru Chateau de la Tour****2004 Burgundy £120**

One of the great estates in Grand Cru Clos de Vougeot. This is a subtle, multilayered & complex mouthful. Intense, powerful with a smooth tannon structure & long finish.

**BORDEAUX Chateau Bel Air****2006 Graves de Vaynes, £32**

Deeply coloured, this wine offers pure fruit on the nose. On the palate, luscious and sappy, with a freshness too.

**ST. EMILION Songes De Magdelaine Grand Cru****2007 £52**

Rich, dark fruit & coffee flavours & a touch of spice combine with velvety tannins for extraordinary balance and a lingering, complex finish.

**POMEROL Bourgneuf Vayron** 2003 Pomerol, Bordeaux £69  
 Rich, packed with ripe rich fruit flavors' and very soft from this forward drinking hot vintage. Characterisitcally this has a very deep purple colour, a touch of chocolate and truffles on the nose and sensuously textured rich fruitiness with rounded, still present tannins.

**MARGAUX Chateau Siran** 1999/2000 £88  
 Bursting with rich blackcurrant and blackberry fruit with minty cedar wood notes & a hint of cherry. Full bodied, beautiful dark colour, good structure & elegant fruitiness balanced by softening tannins & good acidity.

**MINERVOIS Domaine le Cazal** 2009 Minervois, Languedoc £29  
 This traditional, unoaked wine has fine garrigue aromas and a supple mid weight palate of dark berry fruit offset by supple tannins

**SYRAH Domaine de La Jonction VdP d'Oc** 2009 Languedoc £36  
 Deep in colour with spicy, peppery fruits, ripe and full on the palate, smooth and full-bodied. This is one of the House wines at The Fat Duck!

**CROZES HERMITAGE Domaine des Entrefaux** 2010 Rhone £45  
 An unashamedly early drinking Syrah & is drinking beautifully now. A youthful wine with bright acidity, intense meaty notes & pepper flavours.

**CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE Domaines Brunier** 2007/8 Rhone £59  
 A fantastic example and a great food wine. 2005 was a fantastic vintage in the Rhône producing rich, deeply coloured wines bursting with spicy, damson/plum fruitiness.

**HERMITAGE LA CHAPELLE** 1996 Rhone £85  
 The most famous of Paul Jaboulet Aîné's wines. 100% Syrah from 40 year old vines; full bodied & extremely complex with very fine tannins. Rich wild berry flavours and truffled notes- Fabulous!

### Italy & Austria

**ZWEIGELT Little J** 2007 Kamptal, Austria £30  
 This Zweigelt is youthful, clear and concise, with typical varietal aromas of sweet and sour cherries and refined fruit flavors. A lively red wine full of suspense, silky, soft and charming. Best serve slightly chilled.

**VALPOLICELLA SUPERIORE Zenato** 2008 Veneto, Italy £35  
 Dry and robust with an excellent velvety texture. Wild berries, currant, black cherry and spice with just a hint of Chocolate on the finish.

**BAROLO Azienda Agricola Patrizi** 2007 Piedmont, Italy £52  
 Heady with a smoky nose and aromas of dried fruits, leather and earthy woodiness; rich and rustic, velvety and rounded. Finishing with a characteristic dry grip and bite.

**IL PINO DI BISERNO Tenuta di Biserno** 2007 Tuscany, Italy £92  
 Violets, ripe cherries, red and black fruit confit complemented by coffee notes & a delicate hint of citrus, with a refreshing spiced character, all set within an opulent, silky and rather decadent texture. It is extraordinary to have such intensity from such young vines and such elegance there too.

## Spain & Portugal

**TEMPRANILLO Mas Oliveras Bodegas Roqueta** 2010 Catalunya, Spain £21

A soft and approachable Tempranillo from the historic, family-run Bodegas Roqueta in the Catalan Pyrenees. Intense and scented with supple, ripe strawberry and licorice notes.

**MONTE VELHO Herdade do Esporao** 2010 Alentejo, Portugal £28

A soft, elegant and very approachable red showing masses of full-flavored summer berry fruit & a judicious touch of oak with ripe, soft tannins. Delicious & very food friendly.

**PRADO REY ROBLE Bodegas Ventosilla** 2009 Ribera Del Duero £34

A succulent and velvety tempranillo crammed full of blackberry fruitiness. Plums and spice burst from the glass with hints of liquorice and a lovely burst of acidity on the finish.

**GARNACHA TRES PICOS Bodegas Borsao** 2007/9 Zaragoza, Spain £45

Harvested from old vine Grenache vineyards on the rugged slopes of Moncayo Mountain. Brimming with blackberries, strawberries with nuances of leather, vanilla & plums.

**QUINTA DO VALE DONA MARIA** 2007/8 Douro, Portugal £59

The nose combines an array of red and black berry fruit, black cherries, violets and warm plum compote. The palate mirrors these ripe, sweet aromatics with additional spice, pepper and raspberry refreshment.

**RIOJA Contino Reserva** 2005 Rioja Alavesa, Spain £66

Full and deeply fruity with good wood integration and fine spices. Well balanced, with ripe fruit, good acidity and a fresh long complex finish. Favourite of the King of Spain.

## South Africa

**PINOTAGE Whitesands** 2011 Tulbagh £16

Bright, deep ruby colour with spicy bouquet and flavours. Combines power with elegance. Firm fruit in perfect balance with acid and round tannin.

**CABERNET SAUVIGNON Slowine** 2010 Elgin £25

Bursting with blackberry and blackcurrant fruit on the nose, along with well-integrated toastiness emanating from the use of quality oak. Complex and well structured, packed with layers of fruit and a persistent finish.

**SYRAH Jordan Vineyards** 2007/8 Stellenbosch £39

This beautiful Syrah offers dense, rich, black-fruited flavours, white pepper and spice laced with dark chocolate. Barrel maturation adds toasty nuances to the richly textured structure.

**PINOT NOIR Paul Cluver** 2009 Elgin £42

Lots of wild berry fruit on the nose complemented with hints of chocolate, violet and coffee. The complex palate is brimming with sweet berry flavours that are long and lingering with a velvety finish.

## The Americas

**MERLOT Río Alta** 2011 Aconcagua, Chile £22  
'Rich, dark red plum and raisin stew. This is excellent chunky, chewy red. You get some real sense of ripeness through that slight raisin taste, but the basic flavour is big, broad, plummy and fresh.' Oz Clarke

**CARMENÈRE In Situ 'Winemakers Choice' Viña San Esteban** 2009 Aconcagua, Chile £29  
Intense red in colour, this wine reflects the perfect conjunction of fruit & spice, enriched by subtle oak. Well structured, intense but elegant. Awarded the International Trophy at the Decanter World Wine Awards 2010.

**PINOT NOIR Limited Selection Montes Winery** 2009 Casablanca, Chile £33  
100% Pinot Noir with plenty of weight and power: satisfyingly intense but still smooth & elegant with flavours of strawberry & black cherry. Well balanced with a good level of acidity, which provides extra 'lift' on the finish.

**MALBEC Altivo "Secret"** 2006 Mendoza, Argentina £49  
Intense purple in colour this wine reflects the perfect conjunction of fruit and spice, enriched by subtle oak. Well structured, intense but elegant. Awarded the International Trophy at the Decanter World Wine Awards 2010.

**ZINFANDEL Seghesio** 2008/9 Sonoma, California £55  
From the family run vineyard for 4 generations. Smooth and velvety rich with boysenberry Jam, figs and raisins on the palate. Long peppery finish.

**PURPLE ANGEL Montes Winery** 2006 Colchagua, Chile £65  
They called this Carmenère purple for a reason - it's a gorgeous chocolatey purple colour. With red fruits evocations of blackcurrant, chocolate and cigar box, in balance with well-integrated oak (French Alliers fine grained oak). Great complexity, full bodied and balanced with a lasting persistence and a remarkable finish. Gorgeous!

## New Zealand & Australia

**SHIRAZ VIOGNIER The Lane** 2009 Adelaide Hills, Aus £39  
Tiny winery, cool climate (for Oz). Nicely crafted Cote Rotie copy, lifted by the Viognier, which moderates the Shiraz sappiness. Ripe, warm, velvety textured with damson, cherry and a hint of vanilla.

**SHIRAZ Eagle Vale** 2005 Margaret River, Aus £42  
Small producer of handcrafted wines. Intense blackberries and truffle. Mid weight and very elegant for Australian Shiraz.

**MERLOT Fermoy Estate** 2003 Margaret River, Aus £46  
Concentrated aromas of ripe plum and red berry. Well structured with complex coffee and fruitcake flavours with well balanced chalky fine tannins.

**PINOT NOIR Muddy Water** 2008 Waipara, New Zealand £55  
Muddy Water is a premium, boutique winery in Waipara (Maori for Muddy Water) & was 5 starred in decanter magazine recently. Wonderfully rounded, supple and ripe with silky tannins and a creamy structure.
